Prizes and Trophies:

- Random Participation “Tradies microfibre Towel” Prizes to be distributed on the beach on each day of competition.
- Voodoo Dry Caps to be awarded to placegetters in selected U8-U14 and Competitor with a Disability events.
- A Trophy and a prize pack for the winner of the **Brooks Marc Leabeater Cup Open Men’s Beach Sprint**.
- **The Tradies Trophy** will be presented for the Overall Club Point Score for all events conducted on the day. In addition, cash or cheque prizes of \$500 for 1st, \$300 for second and \$200 for 3rd will be awarded for the first three club teams. In the event of a dead heat in the point score the relevant cash prizes will be shared.
- Summer of Surf Prizes as separately advertised.

Supplementary Rules and Notes:

- COVID conditions as at the dates of competition shall apply. As appropriate, details will be advised.
- For the safety of yourself and others please follow all directions of the appointed COVID Marshalls.
- Evolving COVID guidelines and other organisational issues may result in minor programme changes. Such changes as they become known will be advised.
- Sydney Branch Clubs **must** provide U8- U14 proficient water safety personnel with caps/rashies on a **one to 7** competitor ratio. Clubs will be advised of numbers and other administrative details following the close of entries.
- Sydney Branch Clubs **must** provide Officials on a **one to 10** competitor ratio.
- Competition shall be conducted as per the current edition SLSA Surf Sports Manual (SSM) except where detailed in this section.
- All competitors must have their age group clearly marked on their upper left arm.
- U8 to U15 Competitors must remain in their own age group in individual and team events.
- All U17 to Open competitors may compete in individual and team events as specified in the current edition SLSA SSMI.
Note: In addition, Summer of Surf endorse U15 and U17 athletes racing in their Open events. However, no event be “held up” for athletes who choose to race in both their age group and Open age events. Open racing must and will run as scheduled.
- Except here indicated in the programme all events will be conducted in block (i.e. heats (where required) and finals immediately following).
- If practicable some age groups may be joined together in other individual events to assist competition conduct. When this occurs, competitors should nominate their age category and individual results will be recorded for each age group.
- The U15 Male and Female Cameron Relay teams may be 2, 3 or 4 person teams. If it is a three-person team, the team enters one member of the team to complete both the beach sprint legs of the event. If it is a two person team there is no separate runner.
- The “Competitor with a Disability” events shall be open to members from U8 to Opens. Dependent on numbers age Groups will be U13 and under and U14 to Open. Male and Female races may also be conducted but not separate classifications. Clubs shall also be required to provide one to one (1:1) SLS qualified water safety for the Surf, Board and Wade Races.
- Upon application to the Sectional Referee competitors may make up composite teams from different clubs and may be awarded placings (but not prizes or placing points for their individual clubs).
- The Club point score shall be 6 points for 1st through to 1 point for 6th for all events conducted on the day. Dead heats will share the allotted placing points, viz. equal first both score 6 points and third scores 4 points and overall trophy prizes (i.e. there will be no countback to determine the overall club point score winner).
- Consistent with the SLSA Application for Membership form and declaration, Wanda SLSC may take photographs for promotional and historical purposes only. Participation is acknowledgment of acceptance of the consent to SLSA for this to occur.
- The Carnival Committee reserves the right to cancel events and without refund of entry fees if any advertised events for the Carnival are conducted.



Entries:

For All U8 to U14, R&R, and All Beach Event Entries

- Clubs are to submit entries online using the "SEMS" carnival manager system". This is accessed via <https://sems.sls.com.au/>. Please contact the Surf Life Saving Sydney Branch Office for any user enquiries.

- Entries close at Surf Life Saving Sydney at 10pm, Friday, 18 December 2020. Wanda SLSC will then issue invoices.
- Because of COVID there will be no late entries to U14, R&R, All Beach events accepted on the day of competition.
- Entry fees of \$25 per individual competitor shall apply for the Wanda SLSC events.
- Competitor with a Disability Entry Fees are free of charge.
- Entry fees of \$55 per team for competition in R&R events. However:
 - Should one or both competitors in the 2 Person R&R team enter events in addition to the 2 Person R&R, there is no individual competitor fee payable.
 - Should one or more competitors from the 5/6 Person R&R teams enter for events other than R&R, the additional individual competitor fee is \$14 per person.
- Please collect your entry receipt and competitor wrist bands at the Wanda SLSC Clubhouse from 6.30 am.

- Open Entry Fees of \$50 (inclusive of GST) for 1 Individual event & unlimited teams' events (plus \$8.00 (inclusive of GST) for each additional individual Open event).
- U15 and U17 Entry Fees of \$50 (inclusive of GST) for unlimited age group events (plus \$8 (inclusive of GST) for each additional individual Open event).
- Late entry fees of \$15 (inclusive of GST) per competitor will apply. Team Managers will have until 30 minutes prior to Marshalling on each respective competition day to register late competitor entries with Summer of Surf Administration.
- Team Changes (including adding events for an entered competitor or and deleting a competitor entry may be effected by email (info@summerofsurf.tv) until midday Thursday, 7 January 2020. After this time any team changes and deletions will need to be arranged with the Summer of Surf event administration.

Payment of Summer of Surf U15 to Open Water Entries
