

Trailer SOPs

The trailer is packed up and located in the shed for storage with IRB.

Boards should be taken off, washed and returned to the trailer at the end of patrol.

If the tent is wet, take it off and part it open at the rear of the shed.

Storage allows for IRB to be accessed in an emergency.



Tent setup

The trailer is at the back right corner of the tent 3 x advertising boards, 1 at each end and one at the back



Tent setup

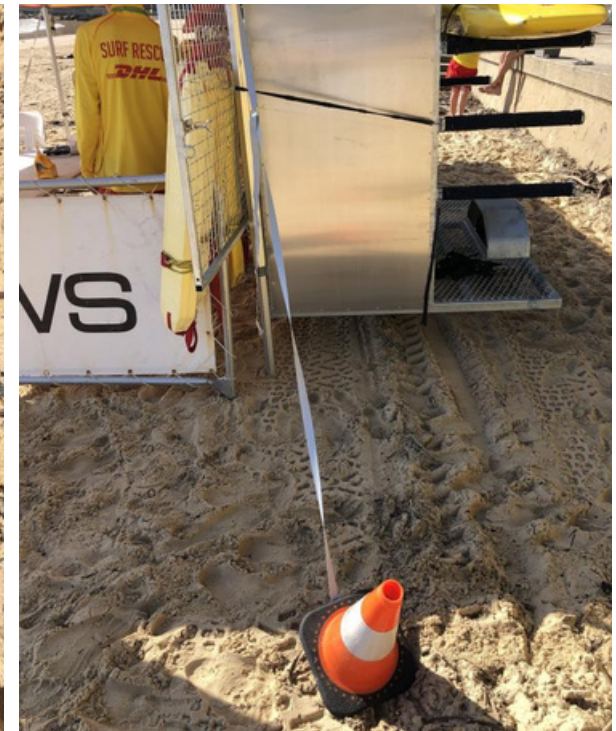


Bungee cords can be used to secure the advertising boards to the legs of the tent. They belong in the peg box with all straps



Tent setup

4 x large metal spikes are used on each corner.
Clip the grey straps to the tent and a hole on the peg.
Tighten strap and put cone over peg.



Oxy / Defib and First Aid Kits can be stored in trailer during patrol.

Spinal board and signal flags in trailer and tubes can be clipped to the metal mesh of the door.

Radios can also be clipped on the door SOPs/Incident Report log, and phone numbers are in the trays and to the left on the trailer wall, as well as spare Patrol Log sheets as backup.



The board bungees can be used to hold the doors open during patrol.
Table and chairs under the tent, and also packed away in the trailer with the cones.
