WHAT YOU NEED TO DO TO BE PROFICIENT THIS SEASON.

1. **DO YOUR ONLINE SKILLS MAINTENANCE BEFORE REGISTERING - MANDATORY**
2. REGISTER TO A FACE TO FACE SESSION ATTEND AND COMPLETE. BRING YOUR CPR FACE MASK AND BE SURE TO SHOW UP TO THE SESSION REGISTERED.
3. COMPLETE YOUR WET SESSION WITH A PATROL CAPTAIN DURING PATROL. THIS CAN BE DONE WITH ANY PATROL CAPTAIN. THEY MUST RECORD ALL NAMES ONCE COMPLETED AND EMAIL DIRECTLY TO CHIEFINSTRUCTOR@MANLYLSC.COM WITH COMPLETION DATE AND FULL NAME AND DATE OF BIRTH.
4. MUST WEAR HIGH VIS FOR THE WET PROFICIENCY.

Please be sure to complete this and show up on time and to the session you register for.

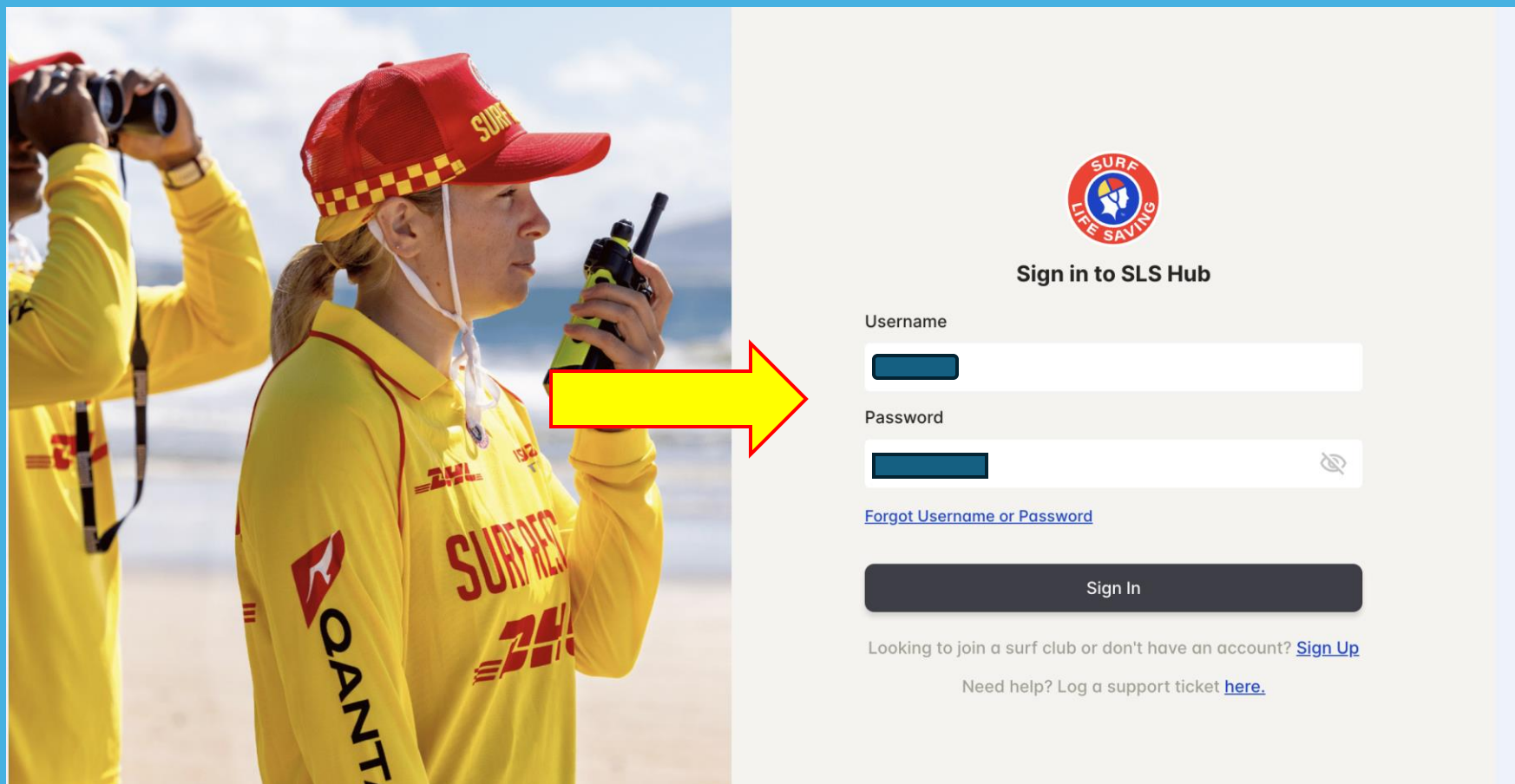

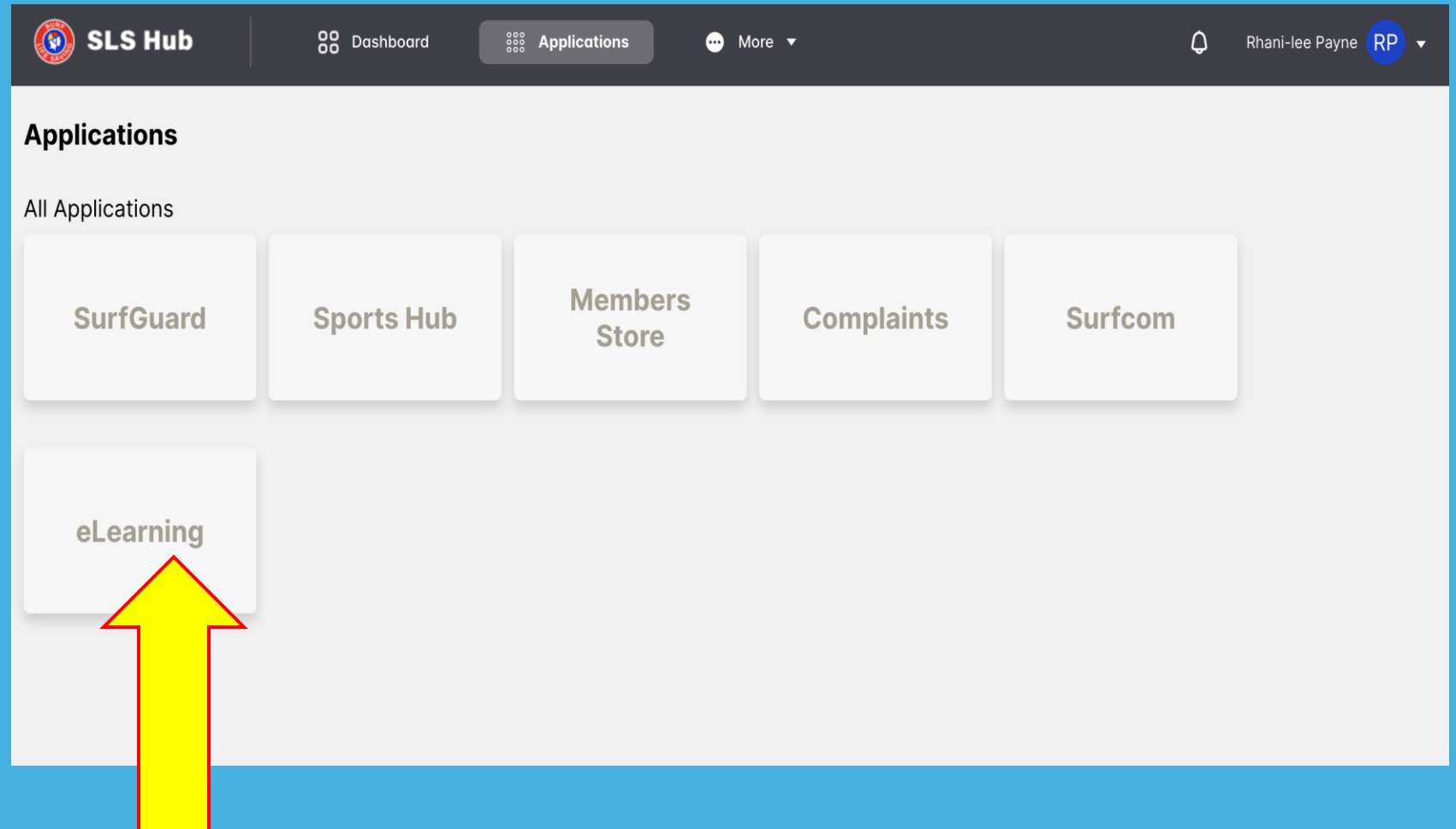
